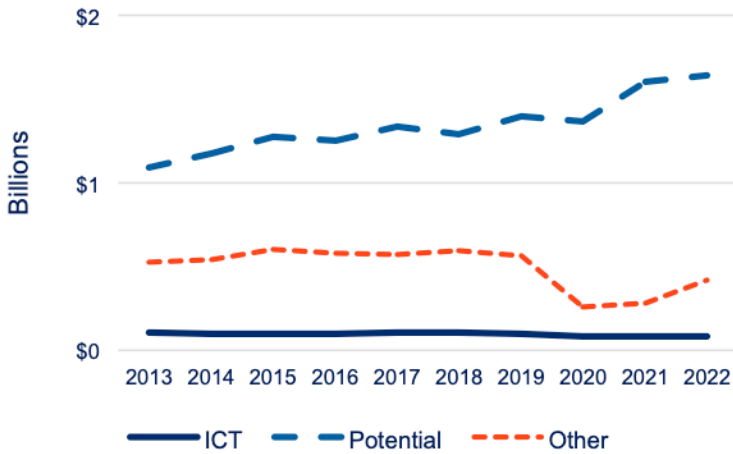




# California's 26th and Digital Trade

CA-26 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports fell from \$107 million in 2013 to \$83 million in 2022 (-22%), but still supported 162 direct and 163 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$1.1 billion to \$1.6 billion (51%), supporting 4,774 direct and 3,170 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$527 million in 2013 to \$565 million in 2019 (7%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

**California's 26th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 4,936 direct and 3,333 indirect American jobs in 2022.**

Europe was California's 26th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

California's 26th district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to India grew from \$8.2 million in 2013 to \$28 million (+240%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$585 million out of California's 26th district's \$1.7 billion in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$11 million in 2013 to \$27 million in 2022 (137%).

Royalties from industrial processes are California's 26th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$268 million in 2013 to \$452 million in 2022 (68%).
