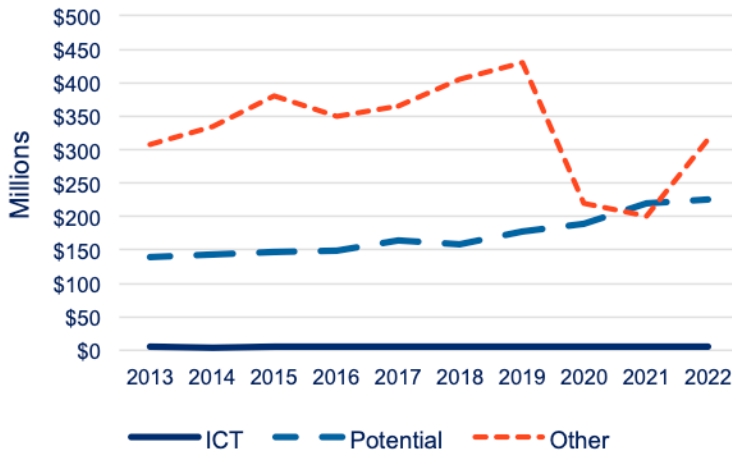




Colorado's 8th and Digital Trade

CO-8 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$4.7 million in 2013 to \$6.1 million in 2022 (32%), supporting 13 direct and 13 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$139 million to \$226 million (62%), supporting 745 direct and 578 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$308 million in 2013 to \$429 million in 2019 (39%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

Colorado's 8th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 758 direct and 591 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Colorado's 8th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Colorado's 8th district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Ireland grew from \$13 million in 2013 to \$27 million (+115%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$86 million out of Colorado's 8th district's \$232 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$518,000 in 2013 to \$2.3 million in 2022 (349%).

Royalties from industrial processes are Colorado's 8th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$53 million in 2013 to \$58 million in 2022 (10%).
