
## Florida's 1st and Digital Trade

FL-1 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$34 million in 2013 to \$62 million in 2022 (82%), supporting 164 direct and 124 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$236 million to \$453 million (92%), supporting 1,564 direct and 1,085 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$563 million in 2013 to \$661 million in 2019 (17%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

Florida's 1st district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 1,728 direct and 1,209 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Florida's 1st district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Florida's 1st district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Switzerland grew from \$15 million in 2013 to \$39 million (+154%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$208 million out of Florida's 1st district's \$515 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$10 million in 2013 to \$41 million in 2022 (292%).

Business management and consulting services are Florida's 1st district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$40 million in 2013 to \$128 million in 2022 (220%).
