
Florida's 10th and Digital Trade

FL-10 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$232 million in 2013 to \$259 million in 2022 (12%), supporting 532 direct and 484 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$653 million to \$1.7 billion (167%), supporting 7,812 direct and 4,509 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$2.9 billion in 2013 to \$3.2 billion in 2019 (12%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

Florida's 10th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 8,344 direct and 4,993 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Florida's 10th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Florida's 10th district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Ireland grew from \$30 million in 2013 to \$224 million (+656%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$730 million out of Florida's 10th district's \$2.0 billion in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$18 million in 2013 to \$98 million in 2022 (452%).

Business management and consulting services are Florida's 10th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$133 million in 2013 to \$646 million in 2022 (385%).
