
Georgia's 1st and Digital Trade

GA-1 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$16 million in 2013 to \$47 million in 2022 (204%), supporting 51 direct and 47 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$363 million to \$525 million (45%), supporting 1,533 direct and 1,014 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$1.6 billion in 2013 to \$2.1 billion in 2023 (25%). It is one of the few districts whose exports of other services are above its pre-Covid-19 levels.

Georgia's 1st district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 1,584 direct and 1,061 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Georgia's 1st district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Georgia's 1st district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Singapore grew from \$7.2 million in 2013 to \$22 million (+206%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$245 million out of Georgia's 1st district's \$572 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Telecommunications services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$13 million in 2013 to \$44 million in 2022 (238%).

Credit-related services are Georgia's 1st district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, but fell from \$106 million in 2013 to \$70 million in 2022 (-33%).
