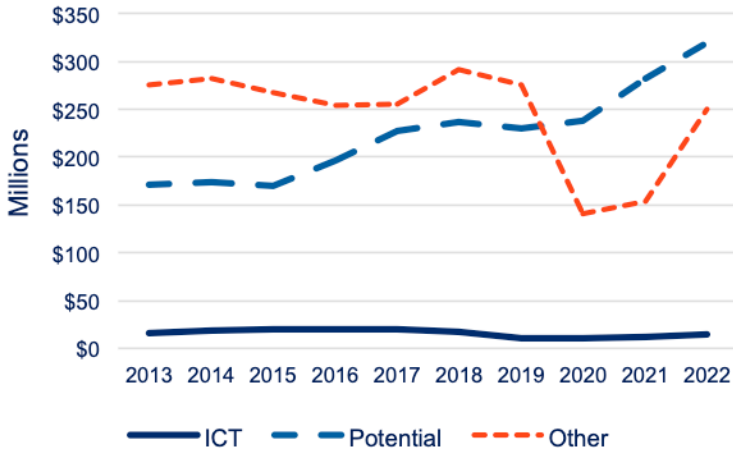




Georgia's 10th and Digital Trade

GA-10 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports fell slightly from \$16 million in 2013 to \$14 million in 2022 (-12%). They supported 19 direct and 22 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$172 million to \$320 million (86%), supporting 894 direct and 622 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services remained constant from around \$275 million in both 2013 and 2019, but then fell sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

Georgia's 10th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 913 direct and 644 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Georgia's 10th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Georgia's 10th district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to United Kingdom grew from \$20 million in 2013 to \$41 million (+108%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$138 million out of Georgia's 10th district's \$335 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Telecommunications services are the top ICT services export, but fell from \$9.0 million in 2013 to \$7.9 million in 2022 (-12%).

Miscellaneous financial services are Georgia's 10th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$31 million in 2013 to \$39 million in 2022 (29%).
