
Illinois' 1st and Digital Trade

IL-1 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$23 million in 2013 to \$36 million in 2022 (55%), supporting 90 direct and 81 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$545 million to \$980 million (80%), supporting 2,940 direct and 2,346 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services declined from \$1.9 billion in 2013 to \$1.9 billion in 2019 (-1%), and then fell sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

Illinois' 1st district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 3,030 direct and 2,427 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Illinois' 1st district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Illinois' 1st district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Singapore grew from \$14 million in 2013 to \$52 million (+273%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$380 million out of Illinois' 1st district's \$1.0 billion in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$9.4 million in 2013 to \$21 million in 2022 (127%).

Business management and consulting services are Illinois' 1st district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$92 million in 2013 to \$245 million in 2022 (165%).
