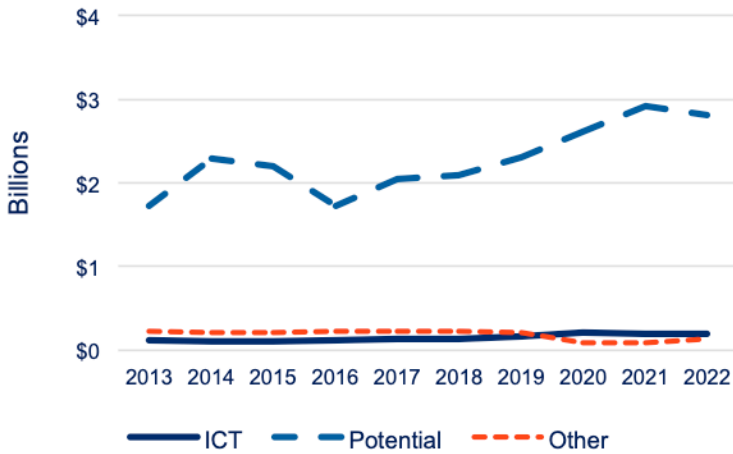




# Pennsylvania's 6th and Digital Trade

PA-6 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$124 million in 2013 to \$192 million in 2022 (55%), supporting 435 direct and 372 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$1.7 billion to \$2.8 billion (64%), supporting 5,395 direct and 6,615 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services declined from \$226 million in 2013 to \$212 million in 2019 (-6%), and then fell further due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

**Pennsylvania's 6th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 5,829 direct and 6,987 indirect American jobs in 2022.**

Central & South America was Pennsylvania's 6th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Europe.

Pennsylvania's 6th district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Singapore grew from \$25 million in 2013 to \$128 million (+405%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$795 million out of Pennsylvania's 6th district's \$3.0 billion in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$59 million in 2013 to \$87 million in 2022 (49%).

Financial management and advisory services are Pennsylvania's 6th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$1.1 billion in 2013 to \$1.7 billion in 2022 (62%).
