
Rhode Island's 1st and Digital Trade

RI-1 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$57 million in 2013 to \$64 million in 2022 (13%), supporting 201 direct and 139 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$372 million to \$496 million (34%), supporting 1,490 direct and 939 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$495 million in 2013 to \$586 million in 2019 (18%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

Rhode Island's 1st district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 1,691 direct and 1,078 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Rhode Island's 1st district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Rhode Island's 1st district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Ireland grew from \$13 million in 2013 to \$42 million (+223%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$248 million out of Rhode Island's 1st district's \$560 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$12 million in 2013 to \$59 million in 2022 (390%).

Business management and consulting services are Rhode Island's 1st district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$10 million in 2013 to \$74 million in 2022 (645%).
