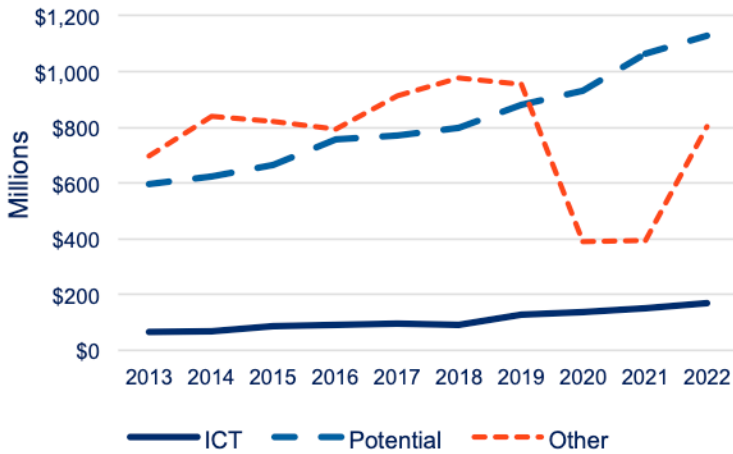




Texas' 30th and Digital Trade

TX-30 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$66 million in 2013 to \$171 million in 2022 (160%), supporting 501 direct and 373 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$596 million to \$1.1 billion (89%), supporting 3,652 direct and 2,580 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$695 million in 2013 to \$955 million in 2019 (37%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

Texas' 30th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 4,153 direct and 2,953 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Texas' 30th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Texas' 30th district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Singapore grew from \$18 million in 2013 to \$62 million (+250%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$476 million out of Texas' 30th district's \$1.3 billion in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$22 million in 2013 to \$138 million in 2022 (523%).

Business management and consulting services are Texas' 30th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$138 million in 2013 to \$425 million in 2022 (209%).
