
Virginia's 10th and Digital Trade

VA-10 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$194 million in 2013 to \$575 million in 2022 (197%), supporting 1,491 direct and 1,399 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$421 million to \$838 million (99%), supporting 3,197 direct and 2,162 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$1.3 billion in 2013 to \$1.5 billion in 2019 (19%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

Virginia's 10th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 4,688 direct and 3,561 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Virginia's 10th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Virginia's 10th district's exports of ICT services to Switzerland grew from \$10 million in 2013 to \$50 million (+376%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$586 million out of Virginia's 10th district's \$1.4 billion in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$122 million in 2013 to \$361 million in 2022 (196%).

Business management and consulting services are Virginia's 10th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$131 million in 2013 to \$436 million in 2022 (234%).
